My neighbor called and told me that you were walking my puppy without using the leash. That is dangerous! You are no longer allowed to take my puppy for a walk.


Please return the leash and solve puzzle #3 to find my puppy's favorite toy so you can exercise puppy in the house or backyard.











Use the colored puppy treats to find Luke's leash. Then you will know the next Bible verse to find and read.






Solve the puzzle to see which toy is the puppy's favorite and which Bible verse to find and read next! In the puzzle, you can only have one of each toy in each row and column.
